Rimrock/Clear Lakes

These beautiful mountain lakes are just an hour away from Canyon River Ranch and offers tons of outdoor recreation opportunities. Rimrock lake is fed by the Tieton River and controlled by the Tieton Dam in the Wenatchee National Forest and sits at 2,922 feet of elevation. While the lake has many different uses, it is known as one of the best and most popular kokanee-fishing destinations in Yakima County from early May through August.

Clear Lake is just above Rimrock Lake at an elevation of 3,011 feet and is also great for fishing as well as beautiful hiking a scenery. There are many different access points and recreation areas spread around the lake to visit and explore.



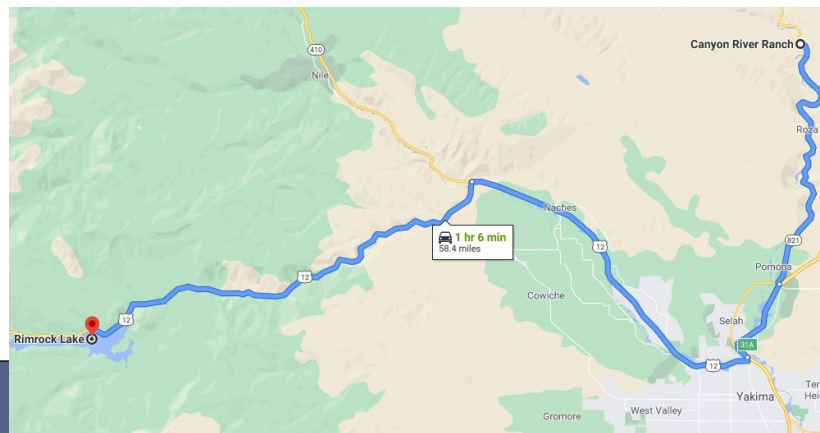
Features

Directions

Head Southeast on Canyon River Road, turn right to merge onto I-82 E toward Yakima. Use the right lane to take exit 31A-31B for US-12 W toward N 1st St/Naches. Keep right to continue to Exit 31A and merge onto US-12 W. Turn left to stay on US-12 W.
